ORDER

Now before the Court is the Receiver's Amended Status Report and Proposed Interim Distribution (Doc. 294). The Receiver asks for authority to distribute \$15 million from the receivership estate to defrauded investors holding a total of 3,897 allowed claims. The Receiver intends to make this interim distribution now and then follow it with a final distribution at the end of this case. To date, no one has filed an objection to the Receiver's interim distribution plan.

The Court, therefore, approves the Amended Status Report and Proposed Interim Distribution and orders as follows:

1. The Receiver is authorized to make a \$15 million interim distribution to the 3,897

allowed claims totaling \$115,901,079.36. The claims will be paid pro rata, meaning each

allowed claimant will receive roughly 12.94% of his or her total allowed claim amount.

2. The Receiver is authorized, in his discretion, to make an interim distribution at the

same distribution rate to any other claimants who may subsequently have their claim allowed by

the Court.

3. The Receiver is authorized, in his discretion, to develop security measures with

the Examiner ensuring that checks can be distributed securely, privately, and in a way that

verifies the recipient's identity. This includes authority to hire a law firm or other agent in

Taiwan to assist the Receiver with distributing checks to the investors located there.
