

1. The Receiver is authorized to make a \$15 million interim distribution to the 3,897 allowed claims totaling \$115,901,079.36. The claims will be paid *pro rata*, meaning each allowed claimant will receive roughly 12.94% of his or her total allowed claim amount.

2. The Receiver is authorized, in his discretion, to make an interim distribution at the same distribution rate to any other claimants who may subsequently have their claim allowed by the Court.

3. The Receiver is authorized, in his discretion, to develop security measures with the Examiner ensuring that checks can be distributed securely, privately, and in a way that verifies the recipient's identity. This includes authority to hire a law firm or other agent in Taiwan to assist the Receiver with distributing checks to the investors located there.
