FINAL FEE APPLICATION FOR SPECIAL COUNSEL**


On this date the Court considered the Receiver's Final Application to Allow and Pay Attorneys' Fees and Expenses of Special Counsel. The Court, being familiar with the pleadings and papers on file and having considered the information set forth in the application, is of the opinion and finds that the application should be APPROVED.

IT IS ORDERED that Borod & Kramer's fees are approved as reasonable and necessary to the Receiver's duties performed in these proceedings and the Receiver is authorized to pay the 10% fee holdback totaling \$1,126.13 that has been withheld for the period covered in this application.

IT IS ORDERED that the Receiver is authorized to pay the 10% fee holdback totaling \$6,877.80 that was withheld by the Order Approving Receiver's First Interim Fee Application for Special Counsel (Doc. 222).

IT IS ORDERED that the Receiver is authorized to pay the 10% fee holdback totaling \$5,772.45 that was withheld by the Order Approving Receiver's Second Interim Fee Application for Special Counsel (Doc. 296).
