## RECEIVER'S UNOPPOSEDMOTION TO APPROVE **COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

TO THE HONORABLE JORGE A. SOLIS, UNITED STATES DISTRICT JUDGE:

COMES NOW, Michael J. Quilling, in his capacity as Receiver for ABC Viaticals, Inc. and related entities ("Receiver") and files this his Motion to Approve Compromise and Settlement Agreement, and in support of such would show unto the Court as follows.

1. By Orders dated November 17, 2006, and December 4, 2006, the Receiver was appointed to serve in SEC v. ABC Viaticals, Inc., et al., Cause No. 3:06-CV-2136. (N.D. Tex) Subsequent to his appointment, the Receiver initiated this action.

2. As a result of the suicide of David A. Goldenberg, a Defendant in this litigation,

the Receiver has negotiated a compromise and settlement agreement with his family members,

the terms of which are set forth in Exhibit "1" attached hereto.

3. In essence, the Agreement allows the Receiver to obtain \$3 million of death

benefits under a policy insuring the life of David Goldenberg. The Receiver believes that the

Compromise and Settlement Agreement is in the best interest of the receivership estate and

requests that it be approved by the Court.

4. In connection with approval of the Compromise and Settlement Agreement, the

Receiver is submitting two orders which are (1) an Agreed Order Approving Compromise and

Settlement Agreement; and (2) Agreed Order Amending First Amended Agreed Preliminary

Injunction, which the Receiver requests that the Court enter if the Compromise and Settlement

Agreement is approved.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the Receiver prays that upon final

consideration of this matter that the Court approve the Compromise and Settlement Agreement

and enter the two submitted Orders, and for such other and further relief, general or special, at

law or in equity, to which the Receiver may show himself justly entitled.
