ORDER ALLOWING INSPECTION AND COPYING OF RECORDS


On the date entered below, came on for consideration the Receiver's Unopposed Motion to Allow Inspection and Copying of Records. The Court, being familiar with the pleadings and papers on file herein and having considered the Motion was of the opinion, and so found, that it should be granted. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the United States of America through the Department of the Treasury, United States Custom Services, Office of Investigations, allow Michael J. Quilling, Receiver, and

his representatives access to all documents in its possession seized from the premises at 4565 Commercial Drive, Bluewater Bay, Florida, and those records and compact disks seized from the safety deposit box at NationsBank so that the Receiver and his representatives may inspect, read, and obtain photocopies of any and all documents which the Receiver, in his discretion, believes relate to the performance of his duties as Receiver, Receivership Assets and/or the business affairs of entities over whom he acts as Receiver.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Receiver be provided copies of the compact disks seized from safety deposit box #00469 at NationsBank in the name of Bridgeport Alliance, LLC, that he be allowed to review those compact disks in Dallas, Texas or such other location of his choosing, and that he further be allowed to print out in hard copy format the contents of any such compact disks which he, in his discretion, believes relates to the performance of his duties as Receiver.
