ORDER

Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for Howe Financial Trust, has filed a motion to sell a vehicle currently in the possession of the receivership estate free and clear of all liens, claims, and encumbrances. The vehicle at issue is a 1994 Chrysler LHS, VIN #2C3ED56F0RH279630. The Receiver was ordered to post a copy of this motion on his website with instructions to all interested parties that any objections must be filed by April 6, 2001. No objections have been received by the court.

A hearing was held on April 12, 2001. The Receiver advised all interested parties of this hearing by posting notice on his website as directed by the court. No one appeared at the hearing or otherwise objected to the motion. The Securities and Exchange Commission, through its regional counsel, has consented to the sale.

Accordingly, the motion to sell vehicle free and clear of all liens, claims, and encumbrances is granted. The Receiver is hereby authorized to sell the 1994 Chrysler LHS, VIN #2C3ED56F0RH279630, to Chris Waddell for the sum of \$5,000. Such sale shall be free and clear of all liens, claims, and encumbrances. The net proceeds of this sale shall be paid to the Howe Financial Trust Estate.
