ORDER

This is a civil action brought by Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for Hammersmith Trust, LLC and related entities, to recover monies allegedly paid to defendants in furtherance of an illegal "ponzi" scheme. In an effort to control the costs of this litigation and maximize the return of funds to defrauded investors, the Court determines that the Receiver should prepare a litigation budget for this case. Accordingly, the Receiver is ordered to complete the following budget by April 6, 2001:
