



following Agreed Final Judgment and specifically certifies that there is no just reason for delay of the entry of final judgement as to Hurst:

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Plaintiff, the Receiver, recover the sum of \$450,000.00 from Hurst.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that all other claims and causes of action asserted herein by the Receiver and Hurst against each other are hereby dismissed, with each party to bear their own costs and expenses, with prejudice to the refiling of same or any part thereof.


