AGREED FINAL JUDGMENT AS TO LEON HURST

On this day came on to be considered the above entitled and numbered cause. The Plaintiff, Michael J. Quilling, Receiver for Hammersmith Trust, LLC, Hammersmith Trust, Ltd., Microfund, LLC, and Bridgeport Alliance, LLC ("Receiver"), and Defendant, Leon Hurst ("Hurst"), have agreed that all matters of fact and things in controversy between them have been fully and finally compromised and settled, and have requested that the Court sign and enter this Agreed Final Judgment. Based upon the agreement between the Receiver and Hurst, the Court enters the

following Agreed Final Judgment and specifically certifies that there is no just reason for delay of the entry of final judgement as to Hurst:

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Plaintiff, the Receiver, recover the sum of \$450,000.00 from Hurst.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that all other claims and causes of action asserted herein by the Receiver and Hurst against each other are hereby dismissed, with each party to bear their own costs and expenses, with prejudice to the refiling of same or any part thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that in partial satisfaction of the judgment, Hurst is to turnover any and all interest that he has in account number 10045447, held at South Trust Bank.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that any and all other claims and causes of action by and between the Receiver and any of the other parties are not affected by this Judgment and shall remain pending before the Court.



The Court directs the clerk to enter this, a FINAL JUDGMENT, as to Leon Hurst.


