**RECEIVER’S OBJECTION TO FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS  
OF THE UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE  
(MEGAFUND RECEIVERSHIP ESTATE)**

TO THE HONORABLE SAM A. LINDSAY, UNITED STATES DISTRICT JUDGE:

COMES NOW, Michael J. Quilling, the Receiver appointed in these proceedings (“Receiver”), and files this his Objection to Findings and Recommendations of the United States Magistrate Judge [Docket No. 242]. In support of this objection, the Receiver would respectfully show the Court as follows:

1. Although this pleading is probably technically an objection, it is more appropriately a notification to the Court that shortly before the Magistrate Judge issued his Findings and Recommendations [Dkt. No. 242], the Receiver was able to resolve a couple of the claims as to

which he had filed the Motion to Disallow/Adjust [Dkt. No. 231]. In particular, since the filing of the motion by the Receiver, he was able to agree with the husband of Arsilia I. Croft (now deceased) that the amount of the claim to be allowed should be \$9,000.00. This resolution was based upon additional documents produced to the Receiver. Accordingly, to the extent the Recommendation recommends disallowance of the claim in its entirety, the Receiver requests that it be allowed in the amount of \$9,000.00.

2. Likewise, with respect to the claim of Patrick D. Griffing, the claimant was able to provide an Affidavit to the Receiver regarding his claim, as a result of which the Receiver was able to agree that the claim should be allowed in the amount of \$42,000.00. Accordingly, to the extent the Recommendation of the Magistrate Judge recommends disallowance of the claim in its entirety, the Receiver requests that it be allowed in the amount of \$42,000.00.
