**ORDER**

Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for Megafund Corporation and related entities, has filed a third motion to allow "A" claims against the Megafund Receivership Estate. [Doc. #248]. As of January 10, 2007, the Receiver has approved eight additional claims totaling \$52,510.00. By this motion, he seeks court approval of those claims.<sup>1</sup>

The Receiver is ordered to post a copy of his motion, along with the proposed list of approved claims attached thereto as Exhibit "1," and this order on his website, [www.secreceiver.com](http://www.secreceiver.com). Appropriate links to the court's docket shall be provided to users of the website. Any interested party who objects to a proposed allowed claim must file written objections with the court by **January 31, 2007**. Objections should be addressed to:



<sup>1</sup> The court previously granted one motion to approve 103 claims totaling \$2,709,790.00 and a second motion to approve 62 claims totaling \$2,155,025.00 against the Megafund Receivership Estate. *See* Orders, 10/11/06 & 1/9/07.

If any party desires a hearing on the motion, a written request for hearing must accompany any objection. Unless a hearing is requested, the court intends to rule on the motion after the expiration of the deadline for filing objections based on the written submissions of the parties.
