**ORDER**

Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for the Megafund Corporation/CIG, Ltd. Receivership Estate, has filed an amended fourth interim application for payment of \$93,575.00 in fees and \$4,039.41 in expenses incurred by the Receiver and his law firm, Quilling Selander Cummiskey & Lownds, P.C., from July 1, 2006 through January 31, 2007.<sup>1</sup> The Receiver also seeks authority to pay \$1,089.00 in fees incurred by his accountants, Litzler, Segner, Shaw & McKenney, LLP, during that time period.

The Receiver shall post this fee application on his website, [www.secreceiver.com](http://www.secreceiver.com). Appropriate links to the court's docket sheet shall also be provided on the website. Any interested party who objects to approval of the fee application must file written objections with the court by **March 2, 2007**. Objections should be addressed to:

<sup>1</sup> The court previously authorized the Receiver "to pay 100% of his expenses on a monthly basis, provided statements are sent to the SEC each month, no objections thereto have been presented, and the quarterly fee applications are filed as required." See Order, 5/8/06 at 4. As permitted by this order, the Receiver has reimbursed his law firm \$4,039.41 in expenses and now seeks court approval of that action.
