**ORDER RESETTING SHOW CAUSE HEARING**

Defendants Bradley C. Stark and Pamela C. Stark ("the Starks") and Defendants Hans Tschebaum and Michael Tschebaum ("the Tschebaums") have written separate letters to the court asking for a continuance of the show cause hearing scheduled for June 2, 2006. The Receiver does not oppose a continuance until June 16, 2006.

Accordingly, the show cause hearing on the Receiver's motion for contempt is reset for **June 16, 2006 at 9:00 a.m.** before U.S. Magistrate Judge Jeff Kaplan, 1100 Commerce Street, 16th Floor, Dallas, Texas.<sup>1</sup> Bradley C. Stark, Pamela C. Stark, Hans Tschebaum, and Michael Tschebaum are ordered to attend this hearing *in person*, then and there to show cause why they should not be held in contempt of court and sanctioned for violating the court orders issued on July 5, 2005 and interfering with the operation of the receivership. No further continuances will be granted.


All other provisions of the show cause order dated May 22, 2006 remain in effect.
