
ORDER

June Slinkard and Norman R. Matson, defrauded investors in Megafund Corporation and/or Sardaukar Holdings, have written a letter to the presiding judge generally complaining about Michael J. Quilling, the court-appointed Receiver. Among their allegations are that Quilling is "squandering our money" and continues to "steal[] what the original thieves have left of our money." The court construes this letter as an objection to the Receiver's second interim fee application.

The clerk is directed to file this letter and send a copy to the Receiver forthwith. The Receiver shall respond to the letter in writing by **May 1, 2006**.
