**DEFENDANT’S RESPONSE TO PLAINTIFF’S MOTION FOR SHOW CAUSE
HEARING AND RESPONSE TO COURT ORDER DATED APRIL 13, 2007**

Defendant 3-D MARKETING LLC (“Defendant”) files this Response to Plaintiff’s Motion for Show Cause Hearing and Response to the Court’s Order setting this matter for hearing on May 11, 2007:

1. Mr. Steeves is an uncompensated former manager, who has sustained a lower back injury that prohibits him from traveling. He has been undergoing treatment daily for a herniated disk in his lower back and the health providers have provided signed statements stating that in their opinion travel would be detrimental to Mr. Steeves at this time and they do not want him to travel for at least 4-6 weeks assuming there is sufficient progress in his rehabilitation. Also;

2. Defendant is having difficulty acquiring the necessary funds to satisfy the ordered payment of this court and therefore respectfully requests a continuance of the May 11th hearing. A forty five day continuance of the May 11th hearing would allow, in

reasonable probability, that Mr. Steeves will be able to comply with said order if ordered payment of this court has not be satisfied by that time.
