**AFFIDAVIT OF SERVICE OF PROCESS UPON DEFENDANT**


Before me, the undersigned authority, on this date personally appeared Brent J. Rodine who is known to me and, after being duly sworn by me, upon his oath states as follows:

summons to Defendant by certified mail with return receipt requested. Plaintiff has not yet received a copy of the return receipt from the United States Postal Service.


