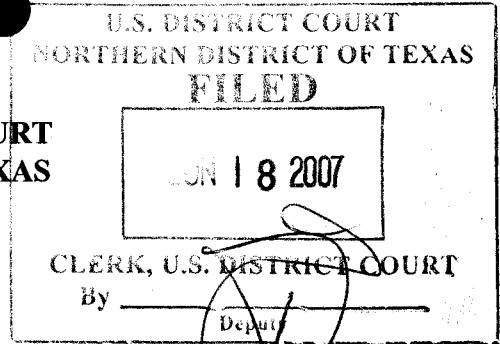

**Fees, Expenses, Costs and Interest**


16. Defendant incorporates herein and realleges in full its answers to Paragraphs 1 through 15 of Plaintiff's Original Complaint.


