**MOTION TO APPROVE AGREED ORDER EXPANDING

TO THE HONORABLE JEFF KAPLAN, UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE:

Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for Megafund Corporation and Lancorp Financial Group, LLC, (“Plaintiff” or “Receiver”) hereby requests that this Court approve the parties’ Agreed Order to expand the deadline for preparing a stipulation of dismissal and proposed final judgment. In support of this motion, the Receiver would respectfully show unto the Court as follows:

1. Since the Receiver obtained full satisfaction of his damages through summary judgment, he now desires to dismiss his remaining causes of action against Defendant. The parties have agreed that an additional two weeks are needed to prepare the stipulation of dismissal and proposed final judgment required by this Court’s Order of October 18, 2006 [Dkt. No. 34].

2. Accordingly, the parties have consented to entry of the Agreed Order attached as Exhibit “A”, which would expand the deadline for preparing the stipulation of dismissal and proposed final judgment until November 15, 2006.
