

**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO EXPAND TIME FOR
SERVICE OF PROCESS UPON DEFENDANT**

Plaintiff Michael J. Quilling, Receiver for Sardaukar Holdings, IBC and related entities, has file a motion to expand time for service of process upon Defendant Derek Schenk, Individually and d/b/a Halo Film Ventures. As grounds for the motion, Plaintiff has shown the Court that despite several attempts, service of process has not been made and the Defendant may be avoiding service. After considering the motion and attached exhibits, the Court determines that the motion should be granted. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that (1) good cause exists to extend time for serving process on the Defendant under Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(m); and (2) the Receiver is granted an additional 60 days to complete service or provide the Court with a supplemental affidavit justifying alternative service under Fed. R. Civ. P. 4 (e)(1).
