**PLAINTIFF’S REPLY BRIEF IN SUPPORT OF HIS
MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT**

TO THE HONORABLE IRMA C. RAMIREZ, UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE:

COMES NOW Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for Sardaukar Holdings IBC and Bradley C. Stark, (“Plaintiff” or “Receiver”) and files this Reply Brief in Support of his Motion for Summary Judgment in accordance with this Court’s Order of December 6, 2006 [Dkt. No. 18] and would respectfully show the Court as follows:

1. The Receiver tried to settle this case when Defendant was represented by counsel. At that time, Defendant indicated that he was unable to pay back the \$175,000.00 of investor funds that he received from Brad Stark. The Receiver then proposed to dismiss this case if: (1) Defendant returned his Rolex watch and personal computer that were purchased with investor funds and (2) he provided the Receiver a sworn financial statement with supporting bank records. Defendant, however, refused to sign a financial statement or produce any bank records.

2. Since Defendant has not been forthcoming about his financial condition, the Receiver
