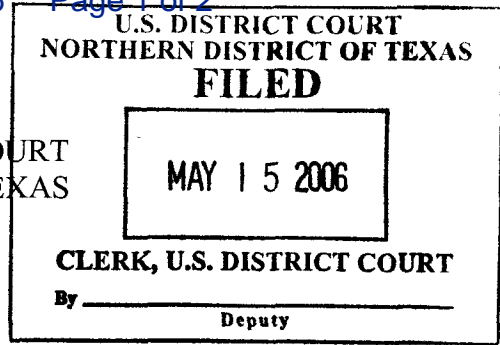

AGREED ORDER TO SURRENDER PROPERTY

Plaintiff and Defendants, through their respective counsel, have agreed to entry of this Order to resolve one of the matters relating to Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunction [Docket No. 12]. Therefore, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED** as follows:

1. Within three (3) days of the signing of this Order, Defendants will call the Receiver's agent in California and agree to a date, time and meeting place to exchange the vehicle.


2. One or both of the Defendants will meet the Receiver's agent as agreed to deliver the vehicle, title document, current proof of insurance, keys, the user's manual, and any other documents and accessories from the factory or dealership.

3. The Receiver's agent will immediately take possession of the vehicle and store it in a secure, climate-controlled warehouse.


4. While in the warehouse, title to the vehicle will remain in the Defendants' name, or as it currently appears, and Defendants will continue making insurance payments pending a final decision by the Court or by agreement of the parties.
