
ORDER

Plaintiff Michael J. Quilling, as Receiver for Sardaukar Holdings, IBC and related entities, has filed a motion to compel discovery from Defendants Hans Tschebaum and Michael Tschebaum. After this motion was filed, the court vacated the scheduling order and accelerated the deadline for filing dispositive motions. Plaintiff has advised the court that he does not need additional discovery from defendants in order to file a motion for summary judgment.

Accordingly, plaintiff's motion to compel discovery [Doc. #38] is denied without prejudice. Plaintiff may refile his motion, if necessary, after the court rules on his motion for summary judgment.
