REVISED SCHEDULING ORDER

The Scheduling Order dated December 16, 2005 is hereby vacated. The following Revised Scheduling Order is entered pursuant to the Civil Justice Expense and Delay Reduction Plan for the Northern District of Texas and Fed. R. Civ. P. 16(b).

Plaintiff shall file a motion for summary judgment by **May 12, 2006**. The motion must be accompanied by a brief not to exceed 30 pages in length. *See* LCivR 56.5(b) (as modified). Any affidavits, depositions, written discovery materials, or other summary evidence must be included in a separate appendix. The appendix shall be numbered sequentially from the first page through the last, and include an index of all documents contained therein. An envelope that contains a non-documentary or oversized exhibit must be numbered as if it were a single page. *See* LCivR 56.6. The court will establish a summary judgment briefing schedule by separate order.

All unexpired pretrial deadlines are stayed pending a ruling on plaintiff's motion for summary judgment. No further discovery, pleading amendments, or motions will be allowed without leave of court.
