

3. On April 27, 2005, the Receiver filed a Motion to Allow/Disallow IIG Claims and Make Interim Distribution. The Court granted that motion on May 25, 2005, ordering that funds IIG received from the receivership estate of Sterling Management Service Inc (“Sterling”) be distributed to IIG investors pro rata. The payment made pursuant to that Order requested a return of approximately 42.78% of the allowed claims held by IIG investors.

4. Since that time, IIG has received an additional distribution from Sterling’s receivership estate and the Receiver believes it is prudent to distribute those funds. By increasing the distribution percentage from 42.78% to approximately 56.05%, an additional \$620,000.00 can be disbursed. The Receiver requests authority to make a supplemental distribution in that amount.

5. Attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein by reference for all purposes is a schedule showing the amount each approved claimant would receive as a result of the additional distribution.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the Receiver requests authority to make the requested disbursements and for such other and further relief, general or special, at law or in equity, to which the Receiver may show himself justly entitled.
