of the corporate defendants. Pursuant to paragraph 8 of the Order, the Receiver requests that the Court adjust and subordinate each of the following claims for the reasons set forth below:

Partial Settlement Received by Investors

Prior to appointment of a Receiver, Donald Neuhaus used money from new 1. investors to pay investment returns to earlier investors in the RIC-J(1) and RIC-J(2) policies. Those payments totaled 45% of the amount invested. Although Neuhaus called those returns a "partial bond recovery" they were purely fictitious because the policies did not mature and there was no bond that funded those returns. They were simply Ponzi payments that Neuhaus diverted from new investors to pay his earlier investors. As reflected in Exhibit 1, there are 18 individuals who owned interests in the RIC-J(1) and RIC-J(2) policies and who have filed 20 separate "A" Claims. Each of these individuals received fictitious investment returns for those interests in the amounts listed on Exhibit 1. The Receiver does not believe that it would be cost efficient to sue each of these investors to recover the amount of the fictitious returns. Instead, the Receiver requests that the Court allow each claim up to the amount actually invested but subordinate payment of the claims until such time as all other investors receive a 45% distribution from the receivership estate.

Death Benefit Claim

When Secure Investment Services, Inc. ("SIS") solicited investors, it represented 2. that upon death of a given insured, the investor would receive a certain fixed amount. Upon receipt of the claim form from the Receiver, a number of investors in the RIC-J(1) and RIC-J(2) policies submitted a claim for the entire amount they were told they were to receive upon death of the insured as opposed to the amount of their actual investment. As set forth on Exhibit 1, there are 11 claims submitted for the entire amount of the death benefit. The Receiver requests that the Court adjust and allow these claims by reducing them to that amount which was actually invested by a given investor as opposed to the anticipated amount to be received on death of the insured.
