

**ORDER AUTHORIZING  
ABANDONMENT OF THE BIE-F&L  
POLICY**

11 On January 6, 2011, Receiver Michael J. Quilling filed a motion for authorization to  
12 abandon the BIE-F&L Policy. The Court has considered the motion, and finds good cause  
13 therefore,

15 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Receiver's  
16 motion is GRANTED and the Receiver is authorized, in his discretion, at such time as the  
17 receivership estate is required to expend additional funds to pay premiums, to abandon the  
18 receivership estate's interest in the life insurance policy number B10090447L in the face amount  
19 of \$4 million issued by American General Insurance Company, referred to in Receiver's Motion  
20 as the BIE-F&L Policy.
