- 4. On November 5, 2009, the Court entered an Order allowing 159 investor "A" claims totaling \$5,980,206.69 [Doc. No. 691].
- 5. On February 3, 2010, the Court entered an Order allowing 81 investor "A" claims totaling \$2,855,931.15 [Doc. No. 723].
- 6. On May 12, 2010, the Court entered an Order allowing 79 investor "A" claims totaling \$3,485,577.72 [Doc. No. 734].
