\$27,693,572.18, of all funds remaining in his possession in the approximate amount of \$341,661.27. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Receiver is authorized, so long as may be necessary, to execute such documents and take such actions as may be necessary to continue efforts to transfer ownership of all policies to Lexington Settlements or its designees.
